Use of Funds

The district/school strategically allocates Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aid and Student Wellness and Success Funds to enhance student support services, particularly amidst the challenges magnified by the pandemic. By prioritizing mental wellness and emotional regulation, the district/school ensures a holistic approach to student development. Allocating resources Lighthouse Youth Services prevention services and Regional Family and Community Liaison underscores the commitment to early intervention and proactive care. Additionally, employing Behavior Intervention Specialists addresses the heightened need for behavior supports, fostering a conducive learning environment. Through these initiatives, the district not only addresses immediate needs but also invests in the long-term well-being and success of its students, ensuring they thrive academically and emotionally.

Community Partnerships

The district/school partners with Lighthouse Youth Services, New Start, Kids Thrive, Best Point, and the Hamilton County Educational Service Center to help to provide support and guidance around the topics of student wellness. The school held a two day wellness event for students using community partners in May 2024 for all students in EK-12.

Impact

These positions impact all students in EK-12 in the school/district. We collaborate with the all staff to make sure there is consistency and continuity throughout grade levels. All leadership team members meet in June and July to review data and set new goals and objectives for the upcoming school year. Professional development has been provided through Hamilton County Educational Service Center and Lighthouse Youth Services to support individual students who need plans and collaborate with building level PBIS (Positive Behavior and Intervention Support) teams to design and monitor our programs.
